Scope and content: Transcripts and photocopies of Augustus Baldwin Longstreet's (1790-1870) letters, selected writings, drafts of an unpublished selected edition of the letters, and an incomplete biography, relating to Longstreet's childhood in Augusta, Ga., education, personal life, family, political activities, judgeship in Georgia Superior Court, conversion to Methodism, editorship of State Rights Sentinel, writings, including Georgia Scenes, and his presidency at several universities, including Emory College, Centenary College, University of Mississippi, and University of South Carolina.
