## Photographic Works of Doris Ulmann SCHS\# 33-110 VMA O/S

Description: 4 boxes ( $\left.2-16^{\prime \prime} \times 20^{\prime \prime}, 2-1 \mid " \times 14^{\prime \prime}\right)$, I book. Total of 6.5 linear feet.
Biographical/Historical Note: Doris Ulmann (I882-1934); American photographer from New York. Educated at the Ethical Culture Fieldston School (ECFS), Columbia University, and the Clarence H. White School of Photography. The Clarence H. White School of Photography is recognized as the facility that placed the Pictorialism movement of photography on the map, finally giving photography recognition as a fine art. Pictorialist artists produced photos using earlier photographic processes that were more akin to printmaking than modern darkroom photography. These older methods produced images that were soft and atmospheric, similar to impressionist paintings.

Doris Ulmann was interested in photographing people from cultures outside her own and travelled frequently to remote areas of Appalachia and the rural South. Her largest bodies of work capture folk artists and musicians in Appalachia, the Gullah of South Carolina, and the Order of Sisters of the Holy Family of Louisiana (an Order founded by African Americans). She also associated and worked among artists and authors of the Charleston Renaissance, producing portraits of Dubose and Dorothy Heyward, Laura Bragg, and Julia Peterkin. It was through her friendship with Julia Peterkin that they produced the collaborative work, Roll, Jordan Roll ( $\mathrm{R} J \mathrm{R}$ ), in which Peterkin wrote a collection of short stories with 72 of Ulmann's photographs used to accompany the text. Many of the images in RJR are from around Lang Syne Plantation in Fort Motte (Calhoun County), South Carolina. Peterkin lived at Lang Syne, which was owned by her husband, William Peterkin. While the images in RJR have long been attributed exclusively to Lang Syne, modern research has revealed that at least five portraits that appear in RJR have been identified as people from Melrose Plantation in Louisiana. It is also now known that Ulmann photographed in Charleston, Murrell's Inlet, Columbia, and Beaufort.

Roll, Jordan Roll was released in two large-run trade editions and one small-run (350) limited edition, which features fine photogravure prints and an additional 18 images (though some of the images in the trade addition do not appear in the limited edition). Of the pieces in the SCHS collection, some appear in RJR, both trade and limited editions, but the majority are alternate views to the images used in either version of the publication.

Unfortunately, Doris Ulmann did not provide identifications of her many subjects. Any identifications are known artists and authors, or have been provided by other sources. The identities of the African Americans named in some of the images were provided through the oral history of Mr. Jackie Whitmore and his family, who are descendants of the enslaved people at Lang Syne; Susan Millar Williams (author of the biography on Julia Peterkin), and Laura Bragg (Director of the Charleston Museum).

Scope and Content: 70 Platinum prints. All pieces are 5 " $\times 7$ " platinum prints mounted on II" $\times 14$ " paper boards (unless otherwise noted).

Due to their acidity, all original top mats have been removed and are stored in Box 4 .
20 of the 70 prints have been mounted in $16 " \times 20$ " archival mats.
One photogravure print.
One limited edition copy of Roll, Jordan, Roll with photogravures.
Note: Prints may be viewed by appointment only. Researchers must wear gloves. Access the images by Folder Number.

Note: The prints were originally numbered with no regard to their arrangement and SCHS changed its numbering systems multiple times before adopting a standardized format. Pieces have now been arranged to apply intellectual order to the presentation of the images and renumbered. Any changes have been noted in brackets.

Note: This series is comprised of materials from other collections within SCHS. As prints were already separated from their corresponding collections over a period of several years, and this collection has already been repeatedly referenced, the items will stay as an artificial collection with the originating collections noted.
