Scope and content: Journal (1855-1886), agricultural contracts (1906) for cotton sharecropping, and other items, relating to the Bryan family farm. Includes papers (ca. 1900-1945) of the Seabrook family of Johns Island, S.C., concerning Sea Island Cotton Seed Association; transcripts (typewritten) of letters of Benjamin Dart Roper to his son, Richard Roper (fl. 1850-1851), relating to Dart and Roper families; and a plat (1892) of a Johns Island farm.

With data (1900-1945) on Seabrook family of Mullet Hall, John's Island and on Sea Island Cotton Seed Association. Including transcripts of 1851 letters of Benjamin Dart Roper to his son, Richard, regarding Roper & Dart families, mentioning 1752 Charleston hurricane. 1892 plat of White Hall, John's Island, and misc. photographs (1890's).
