Biographical/Historical note: Postmaster at Bamberg, S.C.

Scope and content: Papers consist of correspondence, accounts, and other items.

Correspondence (1868-1872) concerns a lawsuit brought against John Dixon and others in the 11th District Federal Circuit Court of South Carolina (U.S. v. John Dixon et al.). Correspondents include attorney A.T. Smythe, R.W. Lowrie, and G.Y. Patrick.

Accounts (1866-1868) are for unpaid postage, postage collected, and other income and expenses. Other items include a federal writ (1869) directing the U.S. Marshall of the 11th District to summon John Dixon, J.F. Brabham, and Isaac L. Bamberg to appear in court to answer to a plea that they render to the plaintiffs the amount of three hundred dollars.
