

Frederick H. McDonald papers, 1952-1968 SCHS 1070.00 Container 11/281

Creator: McDonald, Frederick H.

Description: 112 items.

Biographical/Historical Note: Charleston, S.C. engineer and Chairman of the Charleston Board of Architectural Review.

Scope and Content: Papers consist of correspondence, clippings, printed material, and other items chiefly concerning the preservation of historic buildings in Charleston (S.C.). Correspondence concerns the preservation Bennett's Rice Mill; zoning disputes; construction of buildings in the historic district; additions and alterations to houses and other buildings in the historic district; expansion of the city's historic district; architectural control; historic preservation in other cities; the demolition of three houses at the east end of Calhoun Street and the southeast corner of East Bay Street in Charleston (S.C.); and other matters. Correspondents include city engineer Joseph R. Needle, architect Albert Simons, and the Beacon Hill [Civic] Association of Boston (Mass.).

Included is a typewritten speech (1954) by Albert Simons about historic preservation in Charleston (S.C.); clippings, brochures, and other printed material concerning the Beacon Hill [Civic] Association of Boston (Mass.); and architectural drawings, including a drawing of the facade of 23 King Street, a blueprint of renovations and additions to the sunday school building of First Baptist Church (Church Street), and a drawing of the exterior of 8 State Street.

Note: In 1931 the Charleston City Council appointed a City Planning and Zoning Commission and authorized the preparation of a zoning map and zoning ordinance. Based on this survey a special Zone was established and designated as "Old and Historic Charleston District." The district was put under the protection of a Board of Architectural Review consisting of five citizens appointed by the City Council.
