## Edna Parham papers, 1881-1997 (bulk 1920-1960s) SCHS 370.00

Creator: Parham, Edna Crosswell, 1902-1975.

**Description:** 2.25 linear ft.

**Biographical/historical note:** Edna Crosswell Parham was born in Charleston (S.C.) to Charles Wesley Parham (1870-1966) and Claribel Crosswell Parham (1870-1955), who operated a fruit and vegetable business. Edna was educated at Anderson College and the University of South Carolina, where she received a master's degree in education in 1953. She taught English at Memminger High School and later the High School of Charleston.

**Scope and content:** Edna Parham's papers include newspaper clippings, commonplace books, education records, autograph books, photographs, and materials relating to Memminger High School in Charleston (S.C.), where she was a teacher for many years. These school records include newspapers, yearbooks, clippings, examples of students' work, and ephemera. Early in her teaching career Edna Parham formed a close acquaintance with South Carolina poet Archibald Rutledge (1883-1973), and their relationship is represented here by a small collection of correspondence, poetry, printed stories, and clippings.

Also included in this collection are papers (1881-1997) representing the Parham family in general, consisting of correspondence, legal records, printed material, genealogical records, and clippings. A small amount of material also represents individual family members, including Edna's parents, Charles and Claribel Parham, and several of her seven siblings, including Charles W. Parham, Jr., Harry C. Parham (1906-1985), and Julie Frances Parham (1910-1996). Their papers include estate and financial records, obituaries, and clippings.
