Scope and content: Collection consists of visual materials, mostly photographs, relating to the Allston and Pringle families. They include images of Charles P. Allston, Elizabeth W. Allston Pringle, John Julius Pringle, and Adele Petigru Allston. Of note are several watercolor paintings of mushrooms by Ida Morris Jervey; scenes at Chicora Wood and Windsor plantations; Prince Frederick Parish Church; and a house in Tryon, N.C.

- 11/15-28 Miscellaneous: negatives of photographs; and a photocopy of a cartoon, "The Lumber Merchant" (ca. 1850?).
- 11/31/24 Ida Morris Jervey watercolors: five cards of captioned paintings of mushrooms, one of which has a note to Mrs. Pringle concerning the paintings.
- 11/32/06-01 Miscellaneous images, including photographs of children; and a house in Tryon, N.C. (1921).
- 11/32/06-02 Photographs of Prince Frederick Parish Church and its graveyard.
- 11/32/06-03 Mostly photographs of Elizabeth W. Allston Pringle, two of which are dated 1916.
- 11/32/06-04 Allston family members at Windsor Plantation, S.C. (1910), including Lowndes Allston (Richard Lowndes Allston?) and C. P. Allston.
- 11/32/06-05 Photographs of a threshing mill and cabins at Chicora Wood Plantation.

- 11/32/06-06 Photograph (ca. 1860?) of a young woman. The card is captioned “Villa (Vella?) Carolina Dinard.” This may be a place rather than a person’s name (Dinard, France).
- 11/32/06-07 Photograph of John Julius Pringle, “in a school play at Vevey” (1850s).
- 11/32/06-08 Postcards and greeting cards.
- 11/32/06-09 Photographs of mostly unidentified men and women. Includes a silhouette, and two cabinet photographs of an elderly woman who appears to be Adele Petigru Allston.
- 11/32/06-10 Family photographs, mostly unidentified.
- 11/32/06-11 Photograph of “view from Pyatt house, Georgetown, April 1942”; and a view of the “valley from Wildwood, Sept. 1949.” Also, photographs of several portraits of unidentified persons.
- 11/32/07-01 Photograph album, 1904-1944. Includes photographs of the family of C. P. Allston and scenes at Windsor Plantation and on Pawley’s Island; also, waterfalls (North Carolina?), etc. Identified individuals include C. P. Allston, and Sidney Lawrence (an African American man).
