## Visual Materials from the Theodore Dehon Jervey Family Papers, 1888-1920 SCHS# 1257.00 VM

**Description:** 0.5 linear ft. (2 boxes)

**Scope and content:** Images chiefly consist of glass lantern slide plates. Also included are two photographs of Dr. Alonzo C. McClellan and Rev. Daniel Joseph Jenkins, as well as two glass negative images of Richard Holloway and an unidentified man. One group of lantern slides served as illustrations for a lecture by Jervey (see box 28/261/22-23) entitled “The Readjustment of the Negroes to the Social System of the Sixties.” This group includes images of U.S. census maps, Robert Y. Hayne, Matthew C. Butler, James H. Holloway, an unnamed “emancipated house slave,” William D. Crum, and possibly James E. Wigg. Another group of lantern slides relates to the Civil War and mainly consists of battle maps. The third and largest group of lantern slides pertains to World War I. It includes images of maps and military and political leaders and figures including Field Marshall Von Hindenburg, Frederick III, Kaiser Wilhelm, Leopold Berchtold, Marshall Joffre, Louis Botha, Winston Churchill, Josephus Daniels, Senator Benjamin Tillman, Newton D. Baker, Woodrow Wilson, and Maximilian Harden.

A group of photographs and illustrations (in Box 2) were assembled to accompany Theodore D. Jervey’s unfinished history and memoir about Benjamin R. Tillman and the Charleston *World* (see 28/262). *The World* was a newspaper published in Charleston from 1888 to 1891.
