

Visual Material from the Matthew Family Papers SCHS #: 0684.00 VM

Description: 0.75 linear ft. (2 boxes)

Scope and content: This collection chiefly consists of 19th and 20th century photographs pertaining to the related families of McGowan, Peronneau, Matthewes, and Matthew. They include photographs of John Raven Matthewes (1788-1867), Anna Peronneau Parker Gordon (1850-1936), and Clelia Peronneau Matthewes McGowan (1865-1956). Also included are photographs of George Frederick Matthew (1837-1923) of New Brunswick, Canada, and his family. His son John Douglas Matthew married Rosalie Olivecrona (Olive) McGowan, and there are numerous photographs relating to them and their son William McGowan Matthew (1926-2015), who married Kathryn Kahrs. One group of cartes de visite which were removed from an album includes images of William Peronneau (1768-1848), Eliza Peronneau Matthewes (1835-1923), and John Raven Matthewes (1832-1892?). Other items include a miniature painting (1863) of Fort Sumter, and silhouettes (on greeting cards) by John Bennett.

- 3 Various cartes de visite removed from an album inscribed "To Mamie from Anna." They are mostly unidentified individuals, but the group includes images of a lady who may be Mrs. Edward C. Peronneau; Mrs. Anna S. Peronneau (1804-1866); a man who may be Edward L. Parker (1828-1892); and Anna Peronneau Parker (1850-1936), who married Bennett Taylor Gordon of Virginia.
- 4 Photographs of individuals, including John Raven Matthewes, Clelia Peronneau McGowan, John Douglas Matthew, and Olive McGowan Matthew.
- 5 Miniature painting, 1863, of Fort Sumter.
- 6 Color painting of the Coffin (or Coffyn) family coat of arms.
- 7 Color painting of the Matthewes family coat of arms.
- 8 Color painting of the Peronneau family coat of arms.
- 9 Silhouettes by John Bennett of Charleston, dating from 1915 to 1947. Most of these are Christmas cards from John and Susan Bennett addressed to Mrs. C.P. McGowan.

- 1 Ambrotype, ca. 1855, of Eliza Peronneau Matthewes.
- 2 Ambrotype, ca. 1855, of "Anna Parker" (presumably Anna Peronneau Parker, 1850-1936, who married Bennett Taylor Gordon of Virginia).
- 3 Ambrotype, ca. 1860, of a young man. An accompanying note reads: "Probably Edward Parker, son of Anne Smith Coffin Parker."
- 4 Daguerreotype, ca. 1845, of a man identified as "Mr. William Peronneau."
- 5 Ambrotype, ca. 1850, of a man identified as "Robert S. Matthew" (of New Brunswick).
- 6 Daguerreotype, ca. 1850 (?), of "John Raven Mathewes." This is assumed to be John Raven Mathewes (1832-1892), the grandson of John Raven Mathewes (1788-1867), but

it could be a John Raven Mathewes who was born in 1816 (son of John Raven Mathewes, 1788-1867).
