

## Ball family papers, 1731-1988 369.00

**Description**: 12.75 linear ft.

**Creator:** Ball family

Scope and Content: This collection represents several generations of the Ball family of South Carolina, owners of plantations principally located in Berkeley County. Ball family documents (1733-1980) include correspondence (1774-1980), miscellaneous items, and writings. Correspondence includes transcriptions of Ball family letters dating from 1775 to 1894. Also included are papers of Mary Wilson Ball (1892-1984), Nan S. Ball (1893-1989), Jane S. Ball (1895-1984), Julia Cart Ball Bull (b. 1897), Elias Ball (1899-1985), and Robert Wilson Ball (b. 1900).

A plantation journal of William J. Ball, Jr. contains entries dating from 1865 to 1879 concerning conditions at Limerick and Cedar Hill plantations after the war; difficulties with rice crops and freedmen workers; births, deaths, and marriages in the Ball family; and the planting of a vegetable garden. The journal also contains an agreement between William J. Ball "and the laborers whose names are hereunto signed" (1874).

Ball family writings mainly consist of poetry (mostly copies), including much verse concerning the War Between the States. A manuscript poem (1861) by C.G. Poyas entitled "Our Banner," celebrates the first Confederate national flag.

Miscellaneous items include estate records (1825) of Isaac Ball; lists of family possessions, including an "Inventory of things at Limerick"; lists of bequests of Catherine Theus (died 1866); recipes and formulae for whitewash, soap, cough drops, rice bread, ginger beer, and other items; and "memorials of lands in St. John's Parish now belonging to Daniel Mazyck" (1733).

Papers (1917-1927) of Julia Cart Ball Bull consist of correspondence, including several letters written in French, and miscellaneous items, including poems written by Julia in honor of soldiers of World War I. Papers (1929-1981) of Elias Ball (1899-1985) consist of correspondence and miscellaneous items, including reminiscences (1950) about a canoeing adventure in 1919 "around the sea end of the jetties" in Charleston (S.C.). Papers (1931-1974) of Dr. Robert Wilson Ball include clippings, biographical data, and a few papers pertaining to his position as a public health officer in South Carolina.
