Biographical/historical Note: The Young Women's Christian Association (YWCA) of Charleston, S.C. was formed in 1903, and chartered in 1906 when the YWCA of America was officially formed. In 1967, after several years of discussion, the board of the YWCA voted to disaffiliate itself from the national organization. In 1971, the national YWCA sued the Charleston YWCA over the use of the name "YWCA" and in 1972 the Charleston YWCA changed its name to the Christian Family Y of Charleston." In 2003 the CFY changed its name to Charleston Family and Youth, and the following year, it closed due to financial problems.

Scope and content: Collection consists of photographic material removed from the records of the Christian Family Y (formerly the YWCA) of Charleston. Photographs depict various events and activities of the organization including summer camps for children, the Festival of Tables, annual meetings, tea rooms, and the construction of a new swimming pool in the 1990s.
