## **Pickens District land grants, 1830-1835 SCHS# 1218.00**

**Description:** 0.5 linear ft.

**Scope and Content:** This collection consists of a series of state land grants and plats numbered 1-80 pertaining to properties in Pickens District (S.C.), in an area which is now located in Oconee County (S.C.), and possibly part of Anderson County (S.C.). Most if not all of these are records of lands granted to or acquired by James Edward Calhoun, chiefly situated on the Tugaloo River and the Chattooga River. Some tracts are described as being off the waters of Brasstown Creek, the Keowee River, Toxaway Creek, and the Chauga River. One item is a grant (1830), to Morrison Reese and James and William Cole, of 298 acres on "Chauga Creek." Other grantees include Col. John J. Chappell[e], John E. Calhoun, John C. Calhoun, Floride Calhoun, Edwin Reese, Martin McKay (or McCay), Thomas H. Harris, Wiley Roberts, and Lewis Stanley.
