Biographical/Historical note: Buist, Moore, Smythe & McGee, a general practice law firm in Charleston, S.C., had its beginnings in 1827 with Richard Yeadon and Charles MacBeth. MacBeth formed a partnership with Henry Buist to form MacBeth & Buist. Shortly after the Civil War, this firm became Buist & Buist. The firm of Smythe & Smythe (successor to Smythe, Lee & Frost) merged with Buist & Buist in 1962. Buist, Buist, Smythe & Smythe became the firm of Buist, Moore, Smythe & McGee with the merger of Moore, Mouzon & McGee, a practice founded in 1939.

Scope and content: This collection consists of three disbound plat books. The earliest original plat appears to date to 1872, with most dating from about 1900 into the 1940s. There are copies of several 18th and 19th century plats, one of which is a plan, 1859, of Fife Plantation (St. Peter's Parish, S.C.). Most of the properties are located in Charleston (S.C.) and Charleston County. Other locations include Beaufort County, Jasper County, Berkeley County, and North Charleston. A number of plats relate to right of way for railway lines. These three oversize volumes form part of the Buist, Moore, Smythe & McGee collection of title abstract and plat books (0400.00).

Plat book one is contained in boxes 1 & 2. Plat book two is contained in boxes 3-5. Plat book three is contained in boxes 6-8.
