Description: 6.5 linear ft. (10 boxes + 1 v.)

Scope and content: Collection consists of photographs and slides of the church building exterior and interior, renovation projects (some following Hurricane Hugo), and church activities and social events, including tea rooms. There are also images of Rev. Ralph S. Meadowcroft and Rev. William Way, as well as a bound album, 1979-1982, which is "a pictorial record of the steeple pinnacles restoration."

Biographical/Historical note: Grace Episcopal Church was established in 1846, and the church building was completed in 1848.
