Biographical/Historical note: Gladys Leola Whaley Smith was born on Wadmalaw Island, S.C., in 1899. She was the daughter of Henry Bailey Whaley (1872-1928) and Florence Legare Seabrook Whaley (1876-1935). Her brother Ephraim Clark Whaley (1902-1970) was a graduate of Clemson College. Educated in Charleston schools, Gladys became a schoolteacher and taught at the Belvidere School on Johns Island (1918-1922), the North Charleston Graded School (1922-1925), and the James Island school (1927-1928). In 1920 she also worked at the Episcopal Home and Orphanage in York, S.C. Gladys was a member of St. John Episcopal Church (Johns Island) and president of the Secessionville UDC chapter. In June 1933 she married Herbert McKinley Smith (1903-1973) of Kingstree, S.C. Their only child, Gladys, died in infancy. Henry Bailey Whaley (1872-1928) owned a plantation on Wadmalaw Island where he grew cotton and potatoes.

Scope and content: This collection consists of two photograph albums and a photograph (circa 1920) of a muster of Clemson cadets. The earlier album, 1915-1925, includes photographs of Gladys L. Whaley and her family and friends; girls who were students at the Confederate College (Charleston, S.C.); yacht races at Rockville; Clemson cadets; a summer school play at Winthrop College; Belvidere, the home of J. S. Hart on John's Island, and the Belvidere School and its pupils; and scenes in Rockville and elsewhere, including Pecanetta. The later album, 1920-1947, includes photographs of Gladys L. Whaley and family and friends; the home of W. S. Seabrook on James Island; scenes in Rockville; the Episcopal Church Home Orphanage (York, S.C.) and its infirmary, baby cottage, printery, and Bishop Capers Cottage; children at the orphanage; scenes on Folly Beach including a dance hall; Twin Hill, a potato farm on Wadmalaw Island owned by Henry B. Whaley; the Presbyterian church in Rockville; Episcopal churches on John's Island; Seabrook's Beach (Johns Island); the North Charleston Graded School and some of its students; yacht races at Rockville; Meggett's School (Charleston County); 86 Smith Street (Charleston); the Santee Bridge; and the Stono School on John's Island.
